

ABSTRACT

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The study was undertaken to primarily determine the level of performance of students along knowledge, skills and attitudes as competency bases. Specifically, it answered the following questions: 1) What is the profile of the students in terms of competency percentage by qualification? 2) What are the difficulties encountered by the students?

The method used in this study was descriptive method where 167 BSHRM students from 2nd to 4th year level were used as respondents. A questionnaire was formulated and used as a major tool in gathering data. The data gathered were analyzed and treated through the use of weighted mean, percentage, ranking and content or documentary analysis.

The major findings were: 1) The level of performance of students along knowledge and skills is high with an average mean of 3.37 and 3.36, respectively. They gained additional skills and information about the different competencies. Along attitude with an average mean of 2.09, students were willing to share their knowledge and skills learned through training in school. 2) The study also found out that among the five competencies that are being assessed, Food and Beverage Services (FNB) got the highest percentage of students who passed (91.79%) and the lowest percentage of students who passed is Bread and Pastry Production (69.35%). 3) The study revealed that almost all students believed that the problem encountered was the incomplete facilities of the Assessment Center (81%).

The major conclusions were: 1) Being competent is not only passing TESDA assessment but also who take the assessment and become ready in the hospitality industry. 2) Based on the information given, in every qualification, the percentage of students are becoming lesser every year. 3) Mariners' Assessment Center serves as a testing ground for BSHRM students and it

plays an important role to enhance the skills and abilities of students and facilities in the assessment center is very important to attain reach their goals.
